



MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

The Next Generation Alliance aims to encourage, equip and connect you with the resources and relationships you need to fulfill God's call on your life as a worker in evangelism. Your faithfulness to the following commitments will better enable us to have a fruitful long-term partnership for the purpose of spreading the Good News. Please read and initial below:

○ **PARTICIPATE in at least one NGA sponsored event per calendar year.**

Two main components of our mission are 1) to provide opportunities for our members to evangelize and 2) to provide opportunities for them to get further training to grow their ministry. In order for us to fulfill this mission, we ask you to attend one of the following per calendar year: An NGA sponsored evangelistic event, an NGA Connect Conference, an Extend the Impact Conference, a re:fuel Summit, or a Luis Palau Festival. You can also serve with an NGA Partner Evangelist's event, attend an NGA-hosted webinar or conference call, or make a visit to the NGA Headquarters.

○ **PROVIDE regularly updated information about your ministry events and report results to our office upon request (i.e. for the NGA Year-End Report).**

We want to promote your ministry on our website, through social media, in our newsletters and with the Luis Palau Association! NGA also wants to encourage you, pray for you, and lend assistance if we have the capability. Your regular communication with us will help to achieve this. _____

○ **PAY in full any financial obligations to which your ministry commits during NGA joint ventures.**

We understand your challenge raising funds to pay for ministry expenses. With this in mind, we are sometimes able to extend grace or set up a payment plan as needed. However, continued failure to fulfill agreed-upon financial obligations may result in loss of membership. _____

○ **PLEASE respect confidential information.**

As a member of NGA, you may periodically have access to confidential information of another member, or of the Luis Palau Association. Members are expected not to divulge or utilize confidential information without permission.

NGA Code of Conduct

Next Generation Alliance (NGA) members are expected to uphold the highest standards of ethical, professional behavior, above reproach in the sight of God and man. To that end, NGA members should dedicate themselves to carrying out their missions with honesty, trustworthiness, fairness, integrity, and respect for others.

NGA members are expected to obey the laws of both the United States and/or the laws of the respective countries in which they serve. Members should act in such a manner as to uphold and enhance personal honor, integrity, and dignity. Members should treat with respect and consideration all persons, regardless of race, religion, gender, maternity, marital or family status, disability, age, or national origin.

Members should recognize that the chief function of their ministry at all times is to serve God and the best interests of its constituencies. Members should recognize they are ambassadors for Jesus Christ.

As NGA members and evangelists, members should accept it as a personal duty to conduct themselves at the highest level of transparency, honesty, integrity and humility.

NGA reserves the right to terminate a member's NGA membership if it believes these standards are not being followed.
